Winneshiek Wilberry Winery Spend time tasting wines, touring the winery, vineyard and gift shop after eating your packed lunch.

Willowglen Nursery specializes in new and unusual perennial flowers and ornamental and basket willows. Visit the lovely rural setting and wander the large display gardens. Nestled in the beautiful countryside, you can roam the exquisite perennial gardens which delight the eye.

Decorah's Downtown Shopping Experience Unique boutiques and shops, antiques, clothing, and a tea and tart shop.

Dinner at The Hotel Winneshiek, a turn-of-the-century restoration hotel set amidst the charm of a vital downtown business district.

Luther College Campus provides overnight accommodations. Stay on the beautiful campus and take an evening walk to the Prairie and Butterfly Gardens. Private suites are clustered around a common living area. Breakfast is included.

Seed Savers Exchange is a heritage farm that maintains herbs, rare vegetables, apples and hardy grapes. The educational center is designed to display collections of endangered food crops.
